How to Use Eggshells as Seed Starters

Warmer weather means spring is here! A great family activity is to plant flowers, vegetables, or other plants together. Here's how to use eggshells as biodegradable seed starters:

1. Crack eggs so shells are as intact as possible.
2. Rinse and boil shells to ensure all egg is removed.
3. Let dry, then puncture small hole for drainage.
4. Spray with water, then scoop soil into eggshells.
5. Plant seeds according to directions on package.
6. Keep indoors until seeds have sprouted, then move to planter or outdoor garden.
