Writing with Your Child

Here are some ways you can help build your child's creative writing skills at home!

- While reading a favorite book, ask your child questions about the story. What happens in the story? Who are the characters? Where does it take place? How does the beginning of the story connect to its ending?
- Ask your child to write about something that interests them. For example, maybe they think a book should have ended differently; suggest that they write their own ending!
- Have your child draw or find pictures to go with the story for additional inspiration.
