**Minecraft Coding using LUA, with C3 Cyber Club** (Grades: 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>)

They will be introduced to programming if-then-else statements, for-while loops, and implement their own functions using Lua, a simple scripting language. Looking for a fun way to introduce your child to programming? Why not do it using a game they love! (Note for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> class: Basic reading skills required; Minecraft experience preferred but not required.)
