Spring 2019 Course Offerings

Monday

Mad Science: NASA (Grades: PS-K)

Price: \$105.00 **Minimum:** 15 **Dates:** 3/25 to 5/13 (6 classes; no class 4/15, 4/22) **Time:** 3:30-4:30pm

Description: NASA-approved and endorsed, this program takes children on a tour of the universe! Participants will continue their explorations at home with fascinating information and take-homes. Children will learn about space travel, energy, dry ice, space technology, living in space, motion, and planets and moons.

Silver Knights Coding (Grades: 2nd-5th)

Price: \$180.00 **Minimum:** 8 **Dates:** 3/25 to 5/13 (6 classes; no class 4/15, 4/22) **Time:** 3:30-4:30pm

Description: In Silver Knights Coding clubs, children in grades 2-5 learn to create stories, games, and animations using a visual programming language called Scratch. It's as easy to use as snapping together building blocks! With Scratch, children learn to think creatively, work collaboratively, and reason systematically. Our curriculum teaches new coders the basics while challenging more experienced coders to create increasingly complex programs. Silver Knights provides a laptop for every child.

Tuesday

Silver Knights LEGO Robotics (Grades: 1st-5th)

Price: \$238.00 **Minimum:** 8 **Dates:** 3/26 to 5/28 (8 classes; no class 4/16, 5/21) **Time:** 3:30-4:30pm

Description: In Robotics Club, we build, code, and have fun with LEGO® WeDo 2.0, a hands-on activity that combines LEGO® bricks, kid-friendly software, and engaging projects which inspire kids to explore the world of robotics! Students use gears, pulleys, and axels to create robots that move, crank, spin, and communicate. Make LEGO® WeDo 2.0 AquaBots in this session of Robotics Club. Each week, students build and code a different water-themed robot using LEGO® gears, pulleys, axles, motors and sensors. Make boats, seaplanes, ocean explorers and robotic denizens of the deep!

Tuesday/Thursday

Young Warriors: Karate and Self-Defense (Grades: 1st-5th and 6th-8th)

Price: \$288.00 **Minimum:** 5 **Dates:** 3/26 to 5/30 (16 classes; no class 4/16, 4/18, 5/21, 5/23)

Time: 3:30-4:30pm (1st-5th class), 4:30-5:30 (6th-8th class)

Description: Students will learn Shorin-ryu karate, earning belts at an individualized rate of progress as they develop advanced skills in kata (forms) and kumite (sparring). Students will practice various punches, kicks, blocks, and strikes with instructors and they may demonstrate their progress at a belt testing ceremony at the end of the session. Your child's Gi (uniform) and Obi (belt) are purchased through the course instructor. In a safe, structured, FUN environment, your child will hone essential life skills including discipline, focus, strength, coordination, confidence, and respect. **Please Note:** this class meets twice weekly on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Labyrinth Game Club: Big Kids (Grades: 1st-5th)
